There was discussion about the County inspection report for the Fritz Loven bridge. The report recommends that the bridge be repaired, removed or replaced. It was recommended that we ask the County to place a traffic counter by the bridge so we can get a better idea how much traffic there is.

It was recommended that we consider using Roger our Public Utilities person to do the crack sealing, based on his prior sealing at another town.

Chip sealing in conjunction with Crow Wing County is ready to go.
